



The Adult Residential Center located in New Century, KS (between Gardner and Olathe) houses approximately 250 clients who are sentenced to us from the district court. The average length of stay is 120 days and the clients are expected to maintain employment while in our custody.

In the winter of 2009 plans were made to include a garden for our program and with the help of the K-State Extension Office we created 3 small gardens the following spring. Today we have two gardens, one that is 5000 square feet and the other 1600 square feet. We average over 2000 pounds of produce a year and it's used in our kitchen and donated to Safe Home, a women and children's domestic violence shelter.
