We plan on filling any vacant positions again with the next academy class. Officers have been assigned to Patrol Stations. Their assignment will place them in the community. They will respond to problems by using problem-solving skills to identify, prioritize and resolve issues. Instilled in these new officers is the Police Department's mission/vision which includes community policing.</p>
