

How to Use Crime Mapping

The Kansas City Missouri Police Department partners with CrimeReports.com to bring residents the latest information about crime in their neighborhoods. Users can search by address or type of crime and sign-up to be notified when a crime occurs. The site is updated daily with crime stats.

- Click on or go to www.CrimeReports.com to access the Crime Mapping site
- In the “Enter Address Here” search box on top of the map, enter the **EXACT** address in the search box. Then, click the search icon or press enter
- The colored icons on the map are the reported crimes in your search area
- To view the details of each icon/crime, you may either:
 - ① Click on each individual icon for a detailed view of the type of crime, OR
 - ② Click on “Show Details” on the upper left corner on the map
- To select the different types of crimes reported or to change the dates:
 - Click on **Advanced Search** next to the address search bar on top of the map
 - Here, you can select each individual crime type or select all crime types by clicking “Select All”
 - You may also select a timeframe, or enter your own date range
 - After you have made your selections, click “Show Crimes”
- To zoom the map in and out, use the  symbols in the upper right corner on the map
- To purchase a copy of the police report regarding a certain crime, write down the identifier # which is found by clicking on the individual icon/crime. Bring that identifier # (the case report number) to any Kansas City Missouri Police station. The cost of a report is \$11.00.

To access Crime Mapping from www.kcmo.gov:

- Find and click on the  icon that is located within the black banner on the top of the webpage
- On the left side of the page, locate “Crime Mapping” and click on www.CrimeReports.com
- From here, follow the above instructions
