I. INTRODUCTION

RSMo 84.800 grants authority for a police relief association to be established with the purpose of assisting sick and injured members and to assist the spouses and children of deceased members. The Kansas City Missouri Police Care Team and the Police Benefit Association of Kansas City, Missouri were established with these goals.

II. KANSAS CITY MISSOURI POLICE CARE TEAM

The Kansas City Police Care Team is an organized group of trained volunteer caregivers, who provide non-judgmental support and care in times of personal, family, and career crises. All members, active and retired, and their families are eligible to receive assistance through any of the support and service groups, which are composed of Care Team volunteers. Any active or retired department member or member's spouse may become a Care Team volunteer by contacting a Care Team coordinator and attending training.

III. POLICE BENEFIT ASSOCIATION OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI

All sworn members are eligible for membership in the Police Benefit Association of Kansas City, Missouri (PBA); non-sworn members are eligible after being employed for six months. To join the PBA, members must file an application with the PBA Business Manager and pay the enrollment fee within the first five years after their appointment date. The PBA provides life insurance for its active members at no cost to members and administers Police Benefit Association Group Life Insurance Program.
