## NEIGHBORHOOD SEWER REHABILITATION PROJECT TURKEY CREEK & CENTRAL INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AREA 2

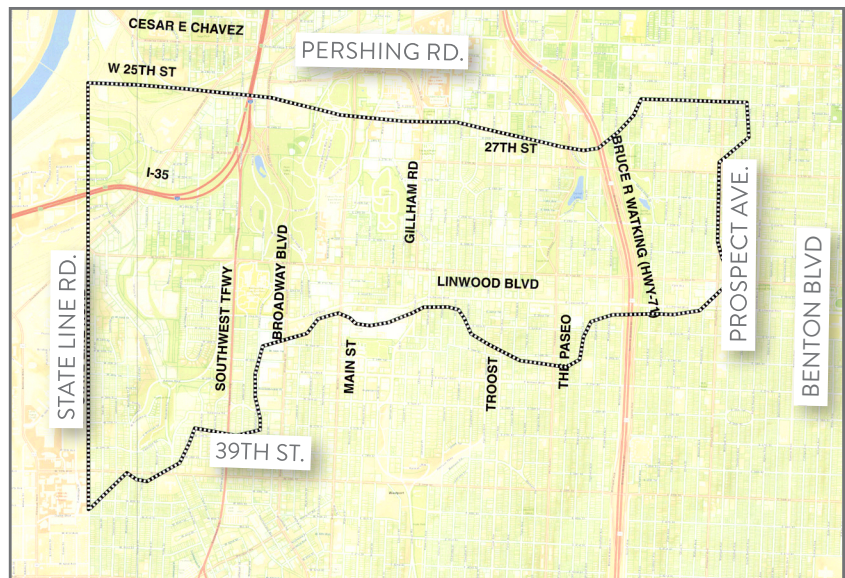
CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULED FOR: JULY 2019 – APRIL 2021

KC Water is working to construct important improvements to the wastewater system in your neighborhood. This project will rehabilitate sewer mains, service laterals and manholes in your area to like-new conditions. When complete, the project will restore capacity to the wastewater collection system, and lessen the frequency of sewer overflows and basement backups.

### PROJECT AREA

THIS PROJECT IS LOCATED WITHIN THE TURKEY CREEK BASIN. THE BOUNDARIES ARE:

- NORTH: PERSHING ROAD
- SOUTH: 39TH STREET
- EAST: PROSPECT AVENUE

# NEIGHBORHOOD SEWER REHAB: TURKEY CREEK & CENTRAL INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AREA 2

## WHAT'S BEING DONE?

This project includes the rehabilitation and/or replacement of:

- Approximately 46,605 linear feet of sewer mains
- Approximately 348 service laterals
- Approximately 110 manholes

## WHAT'S THE TIMELINE?

Construction is anticipated to begin in July 2019 and end in April 2021.

## WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT?

We appreciate your support and patience as we work to complete this important community project. Customers will be notified in advance of pending disruptions, which may include:

- Large equipment creating noise and dusty conditions
- Temporary street closures
- Temporary sewer service disruptions

## WHO'S DOING THE WORK?

KC Water will be assisted by its program manager, Burns & McDonnell; its design professional, Black & Veatch; and its construction contractor, Kissick Construction.

## WHAT'S THE CONTRACT AMOUNT?

The budget for construction is \$8,175,972.

## WHAT'S THE "CONSENT DECREE"?

In 2010, the City of Kansas City, Missouri entered into a federal Consent Decree with the United States Environmental Protection Agency to reduce the volume and frequency of overflows from the City's sewer system. KC Water's Smart Sewer program is a multi-decade effort to address this challenge through 2040. The Turkey Creek and Central Industrial District Area 2 Neighborhood Sewer Rehabilitation Project is one piece of the Smart Sewer program, and is required by the Consent Decree to be completed by April 30, 2021.
