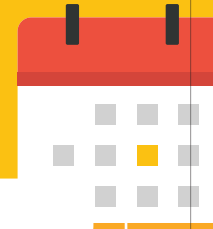

The Ryan White Program

The Federal Ryan White Program was created in 1990 to improve the quality and availability of medical care and support services for low income, uninsured, and under-insured individuals and families affected by HIV disease. It is named after Ryan White, an Indiana teenager who courageously struggled with HIV/AIDS while facing discrimination in accessing the education and medical systems.
