3. You shall pay all supervision fees, court costs and fines, if any, imposed on this case and any companion cases as ordered by the court. All fines, fees and court costs are due within 60 days of this Order unless other arrangements are made at the Violations Bureau.
4. You shall also abide by any of the following **Special Conditions:**
 - a. You shall no have any contact with any victim or witness on this case, or their families, nor shall you enter upon their residential or business premises, without the express consent of said victim, witness, or business.
