
## CONSTRUCTION PLANS

- Must include foundation plan, elevations, structural details and relevant details and notes.
- Master plan and certified options are available.



## SITE PLAN

- Must show lot dimensions, setbacks from buildings to property lines, driveways and easements and/or platted build lines.
- If structures are within 10 feet of a property line a staked survey is required






# 2021 International Energy Conservation Code

- Plans must include an energy code analysis (ECA).
- Select a compliance method (Prescriptive, Total Building Performance or Energy Rating Index).
- Depending on the method selected the builder may be required to hire an energy rating firm to assist with design and inspections.

## **Compass KC**

- All plans must be submitted electronically.
  Reviews can be tracked online.
- Minimum plan review turn around time is 7 business days.



#### **PERMITTING**


Upon plan approval a residential building contractor licensed with the City Planning and Development Department can apply for the building permit.



#### **Business License**

Issued by the Finance
 Department

Valid for 1 year





#### **Contractor License**

- Issued by City Planning and Development
- Valid for 4 years
- Must have liability insurance listing
- City of KCMO as additional insured.







#### **Trade Work**

Separate permits are issued for electrical, plumbing and HVAC.

To find listings of licensed contractors log onto <a href="https://www.kcmo.gov">www.kcmo.gov</a> and search "Contractor Licensing".



## **Inspections**

The last step in any construction project is to request inspections.

Inspections can be scheduled through Compass KC or by calling 816-513-1500.
