Title VI Discrimination Complaint Procedures

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act provides that no person shall, on the basis of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any City program or activity that receives federal funding. Any person who believes that he or she has been discriminated against by the City may file a Title VI complaint by completing and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Forms. The forms and procedures are posted and available at the Civil Rights & Equal Opportunity (CREO) office, 414 E. 12th Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, Missouri, website at http://www.kcmo.gov/CREO. Complaints can be returned in person posted on our to the address above or on-line by email CREOcivilrights@kcmo.org.

Please provide the names and contact information of any persons who can support or clarify your allegations to the City. The City's staff will provide appropriate assistance to complainants who are limited in their ability to communicate in English.

The City's staff investigates complaints received no more than 180 days after the alleged incident. The City will only process complaints that are complete. Once the complaint is received, the City's staff will review it to determine if our office has jurisdiction. The complainant will receive an acknowledgment letter within ten (10) business days of our receipt of the complaint informing her/him whether the complaint will be investigated by our office.

The City has 90 days to investigate the complaint. If more information is needed to resolve the case, the City's staff may contact the complainant. The complainant has ten (10) business days from the date of the letter to send requested information to the investigator assigned to the case. If the investigator is not contacted by the complainant or does not receive the additional information within ten (10) business days, the City's staff can administratively close the case. A case can be administratively closed also if the complainant no longer wishes to pursue their case.

After the investigator reviews the complaint, he/she will issue one of two letters to the complainant: a closure letter or a letter of finding (LOF). A closure letter summarizes the allegations and states that the City did not find a violation of Title VI regulations. This letters closes the case. A LOF summarizes the allegations of discrimination claimed and indicates that the City's services or programs are in violation of Title VI. The letter will also contain a brief description of remedies the City will undertake to achieve compliance.

A complainant may appeal a final decision resulting from a Title VI investigation by submitting a written appeal to the City no later than ten (10) business days after receipt of final decision letter. The appeal must be submitted to the Director of Civil Rights & Equal Opportunity at the City of Kansas City, Missouri at the following address: Director, Civil Rights & Equal Opportunity 414 E. 12th St, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO, 64106.

A complainant may also file a complaint directly with the Federal Transit Administration by filing a complaint with the Office of Civil Rights, Attention: Title VI Program Coordinator, East Building, 5th Floor – TCR, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20590.

The written, signed complaint should include:

- Your name, address and telephone number,
- How, why, and when you believe you were discriminated against.
- Include as much specific, detailed information as possible
