Call The Police

Report all suspicious people and vehicles to KCPD. Nothing is too small to be reported. If you SEE something, SAY something!

Get Cameras

Cameras are vital to help with security, prevent crime, and help solve crime after it happens. Know your system and how to download footage.

Light Up Your Area

Having a well-lit parking lot can deter crime. Good lighting can also improve quality of surveillance footage.

Install an Alarm

Activate your alarm and know how to use it. Ensure that the alarm company has an updated contact and phone number for after-hours activations

5

Assess The Outside

Trim trees, bushes and hedges around your business. Don't give thieves a place to lurk unseen. Secure and lock doors and windows.

6

Take It Down

Do not cover windows with ads or shelves. Employees should be able to see outside, if possible, to watch for suspicious activity.
