## Who we've heard from so far...

#### Online participants

- 932 total visits
- 23 personal stories shared
- 53 responses (climate issues survey)
- 52 responses (climate strategies)
- 109 map pins from 62 contributors

#### Community conversations

#### 79 conversations

- 518 stakeholders
- 90+ hours of dialogue
- Mix of in-person and online discussions
- Include a mix of Council districts but focus on 3, 4, 5 & 6


